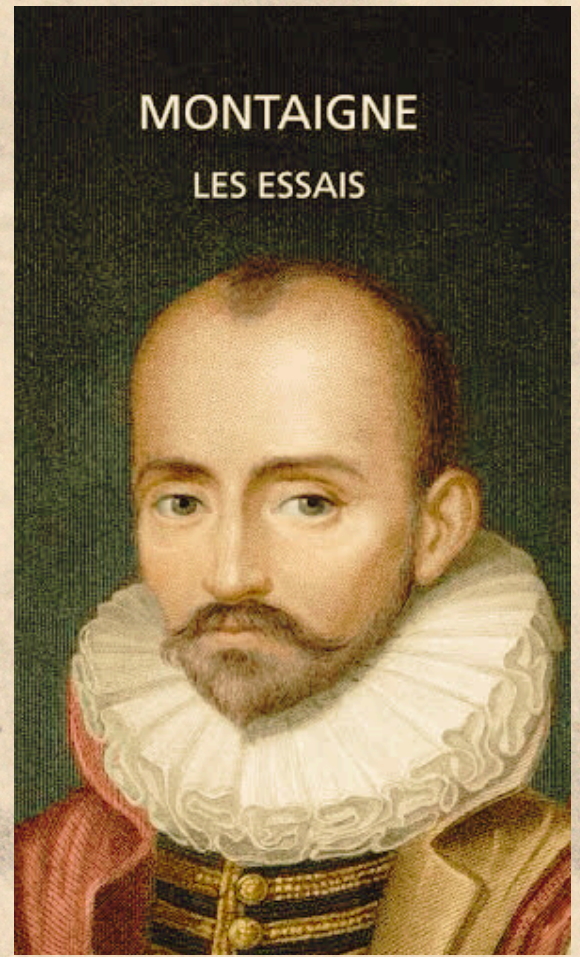


A Window To The Renaissance World
